Goldenvoice to hold annual Coachella Valley Music and Arts Festival

INDIO, Calif.- The 2017 Coachella Valley Music and Arts festival will be held on the weekends of April 14-16 and April 21-23. Goldenvoice, a subsidiary of Anschutz Entertainment Group, is holding the festival at the Empire Polo Club located in the Coachella Valley.

Coachella is one of the nation's and world's most popular and largest music and arts festival. The festival is known for its top-notch lineups. Each year they bring in the best and rising artists and musicians to showcase their work.

Over 235 bands and musicians will take one of the five stages and captivate the Coachella audience at the 2017 festival. Both weekends of the festival will showcase identical lineups to ensure that festival-goers have the same experience. A portion of proceeds collected from festival passes will go toward benefiting the City of Indio and other local charities such as the California Care Force, Silverlake Conservatory and Coachella Valley Unified School District.

"It is important that we give back to the local community," said President and CEO of Goldenvoice Paul Tollet. "The city allows us to hold Coachella here, and we want to say thank you by giving back to the city and local charities."

The Empire Polo Club allows Coachella attendees to campout on the grounds the weekends of the festival. Coachella and the City of Indio have also partnered with local lodging and hotels to accommodate festival attendees who choose not to camp.
