I read your story today about the Southeastern Raptor Center opening its facility for tours to the public and wanted to send you an idea for a follow up.

With the Southeastern Raptor Center being the only non-profit birds of prey center in the Southeast, the staff uses the role of Auburn University's eagles to advocate wildlife conservation as a part of the educational strategies of the U.S. Fish & Wildlife Service and the College of Veterinary Medicine. In 2016, ESPN named Auburn's eagle flight the best Southeastern Conference pregame tradition. Dr. Jamie Bellah and his team are working with a new rehabilitated eagle that will hopefully take flight during the 2017 season in Jordan-Hare Stadium.
